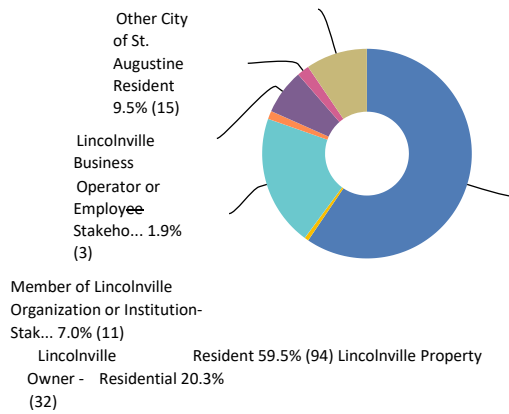

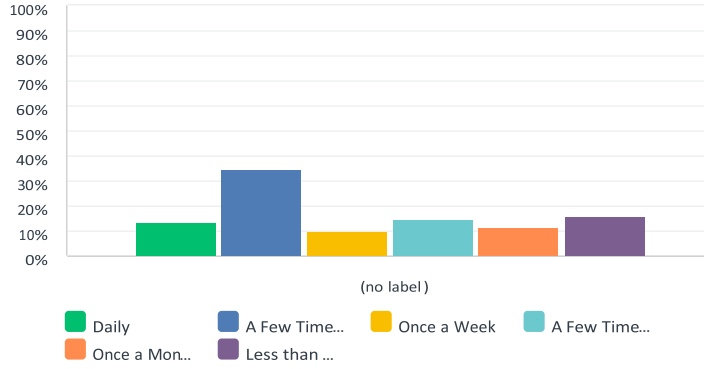
Location

Q3 How often do you utilize Eddie Vickers Park?

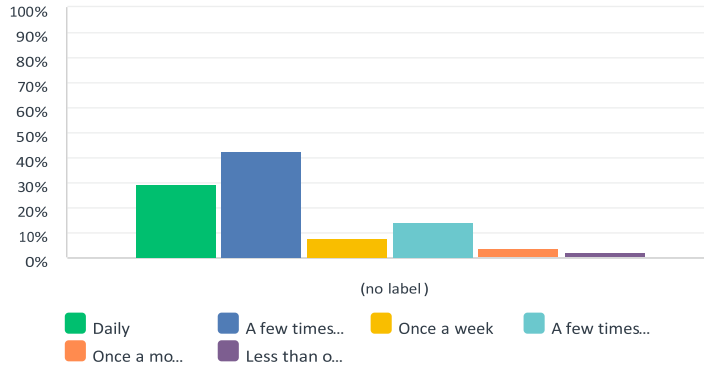

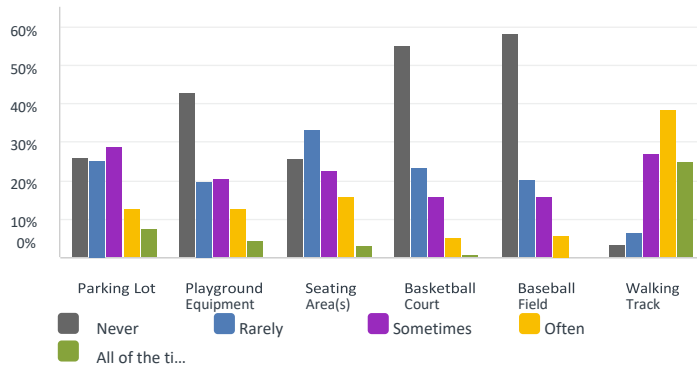

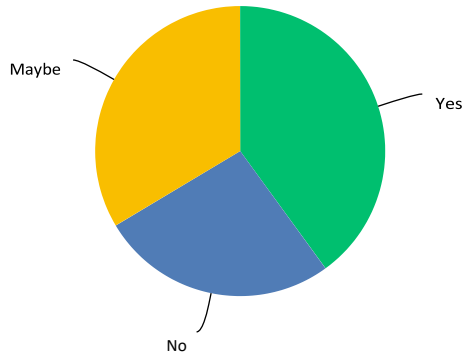

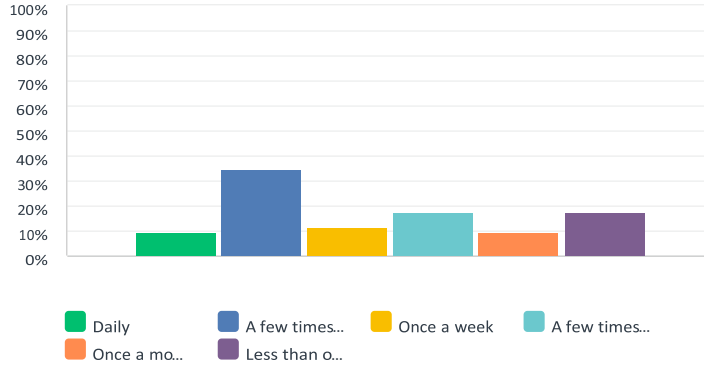

Q11 How often do you utilize Dr. Robert B Hayling Freedom Park?

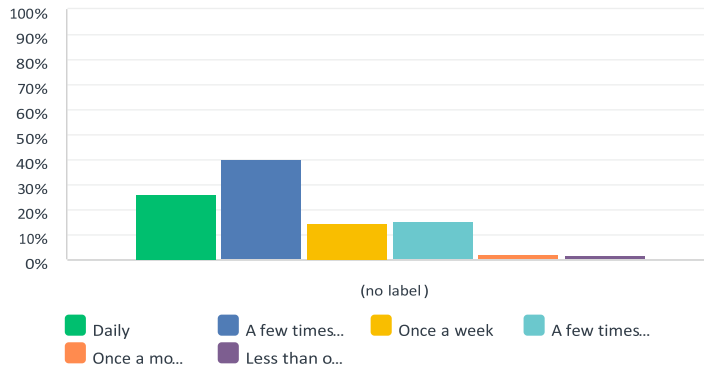

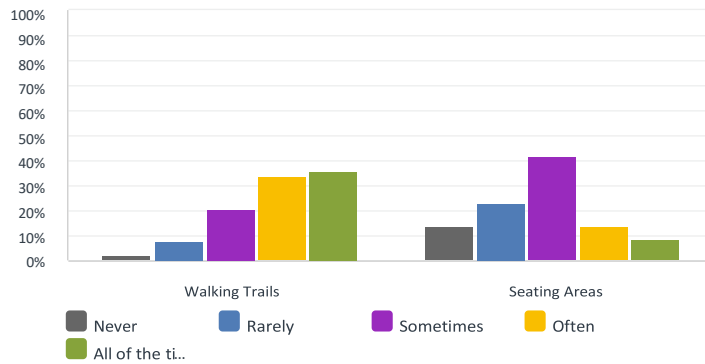

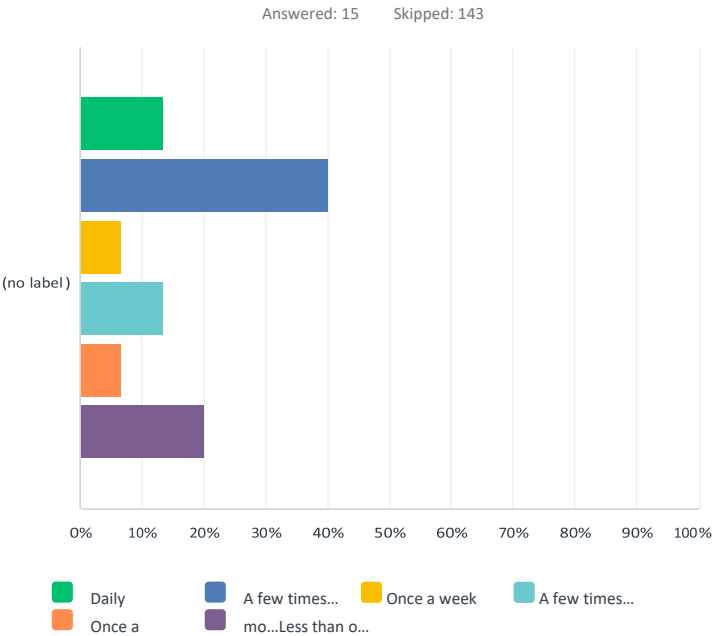

Q21 How often do you utilize Eddie Vickers Park?

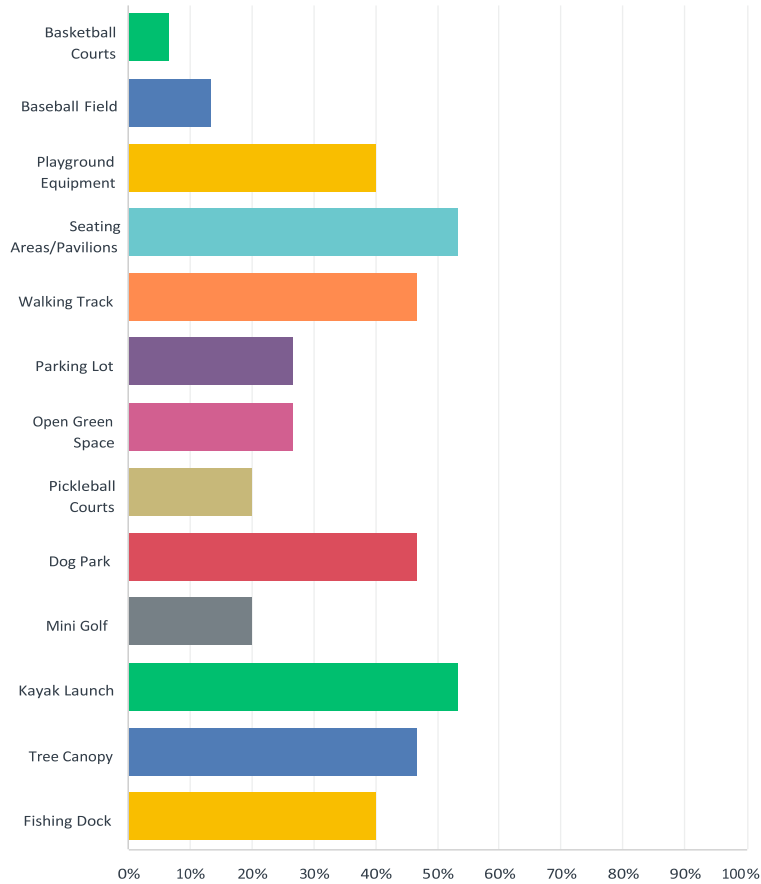

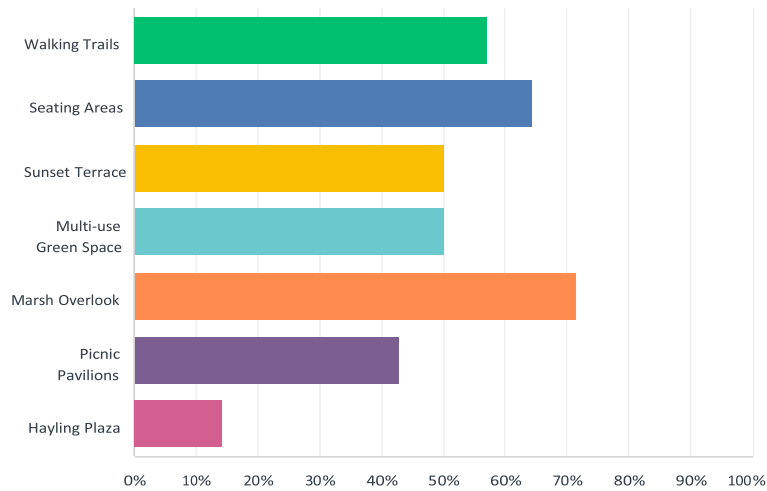

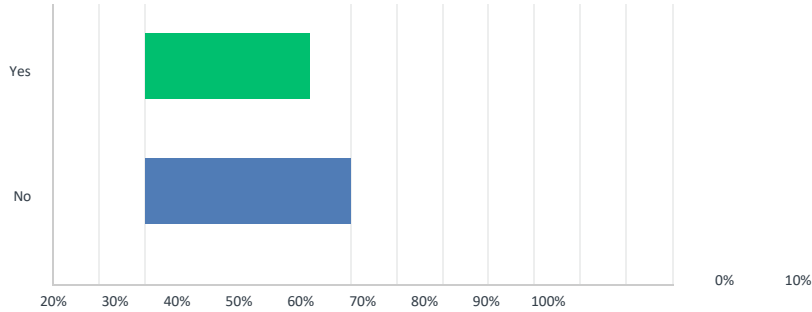
