
Q1 How would you describe yourself?








Q3 How long have you lived in or been a stakeholder in Lincolnville?


Q4 During your time in Lincolnville, would you agree or disagree that the area has changed architecturally?


Q5 Do you agree or disagree that Lincolnville could benefit from the implementation of a design standard and/or guideline?


Q6 From the list below, what would you consider historic features of Lincolnville structures or homes? (please select all that apply)







Q7 Do you agree or disagree that it is acceptable to renovate a historic structure and replace components of the structure with more modern concepts, features, and materials?






Q9 Do you agree or disagree that architectural guidelines or standards should address the scale or size of newly constructed structures in Lincolnville?


Q10 Do you agree or disagree that architectural design standards or guidelines should address the exterior color of historic structures?











Q15 Do you agree or disagree that the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnville area?





Q16 Do you agree or disagree that the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnville area?





Q17 Do you agree or disagree that the roof pitch on the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnville area?






